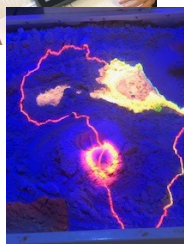
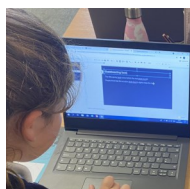
Congratulations to Miss Pirot who is now Mrs Kempster.
