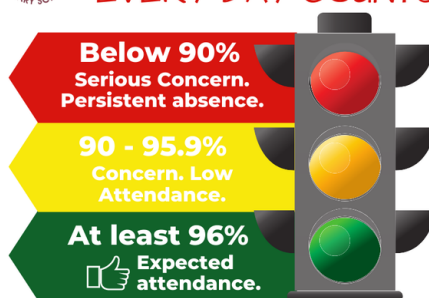

Welcome back to Term 4

As you can see from the key dates we have a term full of exciting experiences and opportunities for all the children.

Thank you to those parents who have already registered for the Online National Safety Programme. We are now a "National Online Safety" Certified School.

From 24 February the Government will remove the **legal** requirement to self-isolate following a positive Covid test. **Adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days.**

Guidance still states to take a test if you have COVID-19 symptoms, and to stay at home if you test positive.

As a school we are looking forward to welcoming you in throughout the rest of the year.

New booster sessions have been scheduled for this term—please support the school in allowing your child to attend the 5 focused sessions if they have been invited.

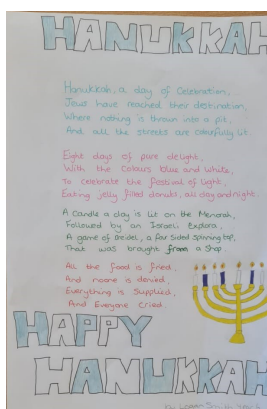

Both our Y5/6 and Y3/4 teams finished in 4th place—a very close competition.

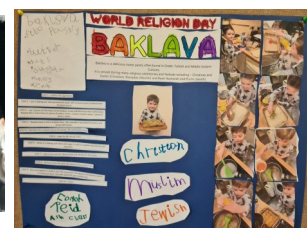
Thanks to Mr Baker-May who ran a very successful half-term football club, despite the rain and very muddy conditions!
