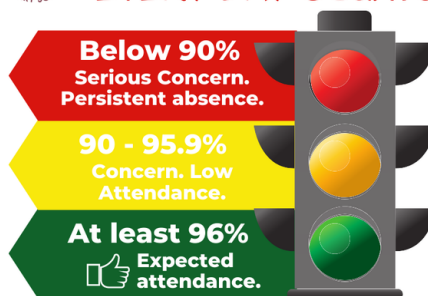

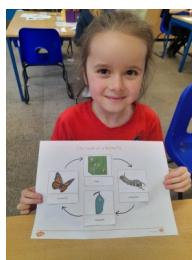

Y3 & 4 went on a 'Mission to Mars'



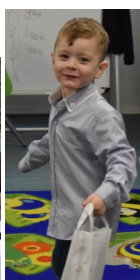
Y6 investigated soil from Mars and craters and have submitted their entries for the GSS competition

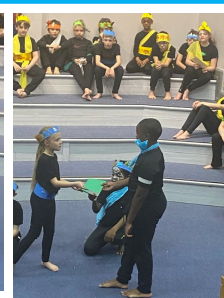
### Poetry

### Covid Update

Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and where possible avoid contact with other people. They can go back to education or child-care setting when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough.

If a child or young person has a positive COVID-19 test result they should try to stay at home and where possible avoid contact with other people for **3 days after the day they took the test**. The risk of passing the infection on to others is much lower after 3 days if they feel well and do not have a high temperature.

Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days. No requirement to test from day 5.
