Dear Families of Year 6 children

Re: 'Dangerous Curriculum'

As we do every year, we have arranged for the children in Year 6 to experience the 'Dangerous Curriculum'. This will take place on Tuesday 4th and Tuesday 11th June.

The Dangerous Curriculum follows the principles of the Forest School to inspire children to write. All activities will take place in the school grounds.

On Tuesday 4th June we expect to take part in activities involving water so children will need to wear old clothes and bring in a towel, underwear and uniform to change into afterwards. Children are allowed to bring in a water pistol if they wish but this is their own responsibility, alternatively a plastic bottle works just as well. However, children should not bring in water balloons.

On Tuesday 11th June we plan to take part in campfire activities. On this day, children should come into school wearing old clothes.

We will endeavour to send a text the night before the planned activity and remind the children as we will obviously take heed of the weather forecast first but the dates suggested will hopefully be the ones we go with.

Please emphasise to your child that if their behaviour during any of the activities is deemed unacceptable or inappropriate they will be excluded from the following activity.

Please remember if your child uses an inhaler or any other medication they need to have this with them each day.

We expect all children to take part in these activities.
