SATs Week: May 9th to May 12th

Tuesday 9th May 2023	Grammar & Punctuation test - 45 minutes Spelling Test - 20 minutes
Weds 10th May 2023	English Reading Test - 60 minutes
Thurs 11th May 2023	Mathematics Arithmetics (Paper 1) - 30 minutes Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 2) - 40 minutes
Friday 12th May 2023	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes



SATs Week: May 9th to May 12th:

- Timetable variation for the day give the greatest opportunity for success for all children (3 sittings)
- Prompt, readers, additional time
- Tests in classrooms/learning areas not hall
- Breakfast offered to all Y6 in at 8.20am!
- Snacks during morning provided



Access Arrangements

Some children have already been awarded access arrangements, such as:

- Tests papers read to them Not the Reading paper
- Small breaks
- A scribe
- Additional time

Small grouping in place for all children to request a question to be read to them.

Test Results

- School receives results in July
 - Papers are marked electronically
- Each pupil will receive raw score (numbers and marks awarded), scaled score (100 is expected) and confirmation as to whether they have attained the National Standards.
- Issued on end of year report
