- Snacks during morning provided




## **Access Arrangements**

Some children have already been awarded access arrangements, such as:

- Tests papers read to them Not the Reading paper
- Small breaks
- A scribe
- Additional time

Small grouping in place for all children to request a question to be read to them.



## **Emergency Arrangements**

  - If your child has an accident which could affect their ability to write we would apply for access arrangements let us know as soon as possible....
- Please let us know if there are any major changes at home that may affect your child prior to or during SATs week.

#### Test Results

- School receives results in July
  - Papers are marked electronically
- Each pupil will receive raw score (numbers and marks awarded), scaled score (100 is expected) and confirmation as to whether they have attained the National Standards.
- Issued on end of year report
